


# **Purpose of Library Visit:-**



# **Library Services:**



# **Library Collection:**



# Suggestion and conclusion:

Keeping in view the results obtained by the investigation of this study. The following suggesting and conclusion are made.

- 1) A majority of respondents visit the library with the purpose of consulting books, consulting reference tools, for periodicals so the library should be developed as need based collection of next books and reference sources.
- 2) The result of the present study revealed that most of the user's are not aware of the most of the service like CAS, SDI, Inter library loan service, Bibliographic services so it is suggested that proper orientation/ education programme should be organize for the user's.
- 3) Talking to researcher's there is only books issued on special request or there is no facility on newspaper and in adequate of periodicals, so it is therefore suggested that circulation services are provided to it's users and journal imprint from as well as e-journals newspaper, A-V material, multimedia material, OPAC'S should be provided to it's user's.
- 4) The present study revealed that there is inadequate of online databases. Internet services multimedia services so therefore it is suggested that these services should be initiated through proper techniques.
- 5) User studies may be carried out from time to time with a view to determine the need to the library user's and providing better services to them.
